

Oppressed by high taxes in Durham County?

Each year the Durham County commissioners vote to give taxpayers' dollars to the local chapter of an organization that kills more than 300,000 human beings each year. That organization is known as Planned Parenthood.

What is the number one cause of death in the African-American community? Aborticide (induced abortion). Since 1973, decriminalized aborticide has killed more African-Americans than AIDS, cancer, diabetes, heart disease, and violent crime combined. Every week, more blacks die in American abortion clinics than were killed in the entire Vietnam war. And the largest chain of abortion clinics in the United States is operated by Planned Parenthood.

"We have now reached a point in this country that African-American women, though they make up 12% of the population, they account for 37% of the abortions. An African-American baby is almost five times more likely to be aborted than a white child. The abortion industry at this point kills as many African-American people every four days as the Klan killed in 150 years.
